Meeting Minutes

April 18, 2017

Chairman Abrams called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Present: Trustees Bernard Abrams, Wayne Little, Aaron Aurand, and Carol Ware. Also present: Paul Campo, Village Attorney.

Oaths of office were administered to Bernard Abrams and Aaron Aurand.

Selection of Chairman of the Board of Trustees: Mr. Little moved to select Bernard Abrams to serve as Chairman. Seconded by Ms. Ware. Motion passed 4-0.

Jennifer Chiarelli arrived and was administered her oath of office.

Consideration of ordinance regarding public nuisance: Mr. Aurand moved to introduce the bill for its two readings. Mr. Abrams seconded. Motion passed 5-0. The title to Bill No. 2017-04-18-1 — AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC NUISANCE REGULATION AND ABATEMENT — was read once by Ms. Chiarelli and again by Mr. Abrams. Mr. Aurand moved to approve the bill as ordinance. Ms. Chiarelli seconded. Vote as follows: Abrams: yes; Little: yes; Aurand: yes; Ware: yes, Chiarelli: yes. Motion passed and ordinance adopted.

Consideration of ordinance regarding dangerous buildings: Mr. Aurand moved to introduce the bill for its two readings. Ms. Chiarelli seconded. Motion passed 5-0. The title to Bill No. 2017-04-18-2 – AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A DANGEROUS BUILDING ORDINANCE – was read once by Mr. Abrams and again by Ms. Ware. Mr. Aurand moved to approve the bill as ordinance. Ms. Chiarelli seconded. Vote as follows: Abrams: yes; Little: yes; Aurand: yes; Ware: yes, Chiarelli: yes. Motion passed and ordinance adopted.

Consideration of an ordinance calling an election to forego elections for 6 years if number of candidates does not exceed number of open seats: Mr. Aurand moved to introduce the bill for its two readings. Ms. Chiarelli seconded. Motion passed 5-0. The title to Bill No. 2017-04-18-3 – AN ORDINANCE SETTING AN ELECTION NOVEMBER 7, 2017, FOR THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH LLOYD, MISSOURI, TO DECIDE WHETHER TO FOREGO ANNUAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS FOR SIX YEARS IF THE NUMBER OF CANDIDATES FILING EQUAL THE NUMBER OF SEATS UP FOR ELECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 115.124 RSMO. – was read twice by Mr. Abrams. Mr. Aurand moved to approve the bill as ordinance. Ms. Chiarelli seconded. Vote as follows: Abrams: yes; Little: yes; Aurand: yes; Ware: yes, Chiarelli: yes. Motion passed and ordinance adopted.

Update on banking signature authorizations: Mr. Abrams moved to approve add all Trustees as signatories to bank account, provided that 2 signatures are required. Ms. Chiarelli seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Re-appoint members to the Planning and Zoning Commission: Motion by Ms. Ware to reappoint the following persons to the Commission for the term stated: Bill Boice: 5 years; Linda Enright: 4 years; Carolyn Pope: 3 years: Dr. Heath Rose: 2 years, with one vacant position. Ms. Chiarelli seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Report from Trustees on any issues of concern: Mr. Little stated the Village's website was operational. He also stated he has found a container suitable for emergency preparedness purposes and awaiting response from developer re storage site.
